2023-2027 objectives

- 3. Develop the staff's understanding of Attachment and Trauma by gaining advice from external agencies engaging in external training.
- 4. Develop approaches to inspire boys in writing, especially for the higher achievers.
- 5. Develop strategies to support personal development by encouraging regulation and supporting children to understand their emotions.
- 6. Further develop the curriculum to ensure children make good progress, especially boys by applying key skills of reading and writing across the curriculum.
- 7. To raise levels of attainment in core subjects for vulnerable learners.
