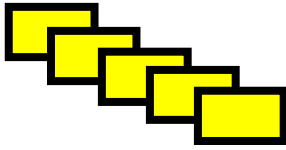

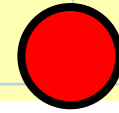
As she approaches the art trays, she notices a worrying gap. The glue stick tray has vanished! Somebody has moved the full tray!
